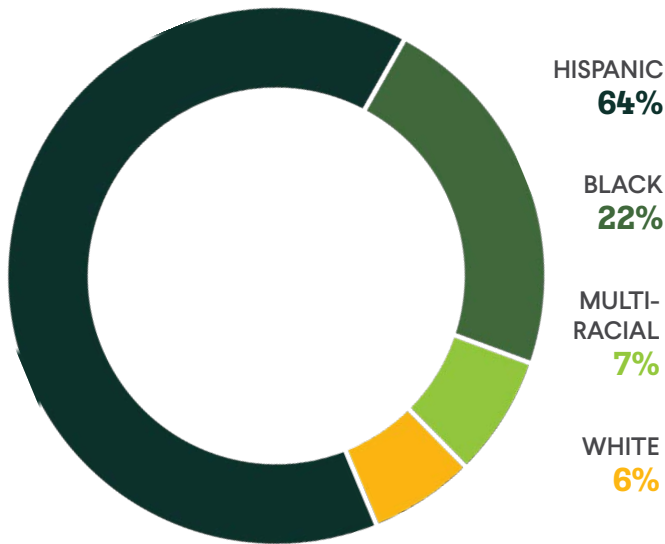

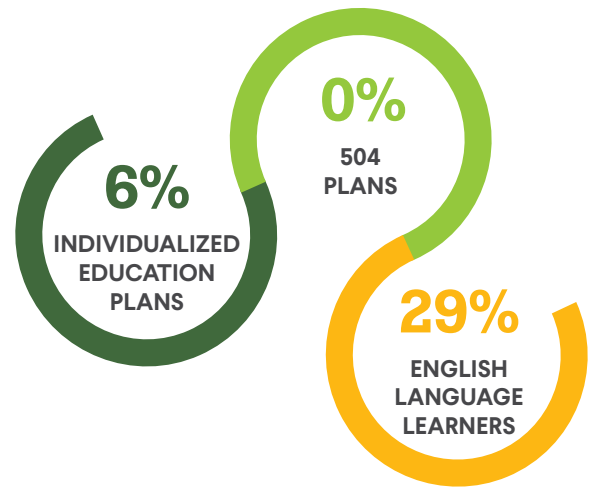

## STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS



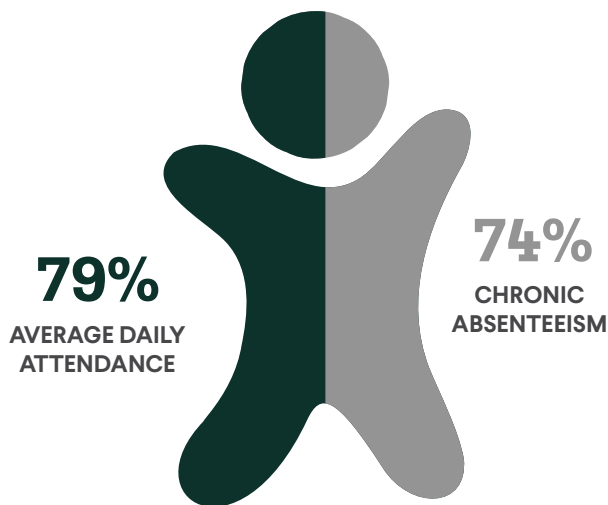

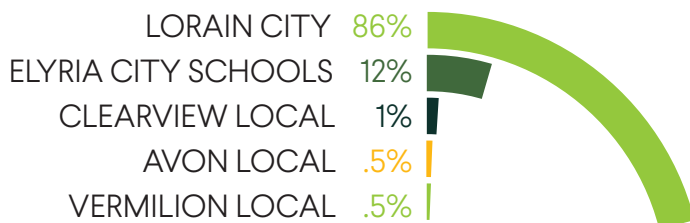

## ACADEMIC PROGRESS

Through a well-rounded curriculum that engages students, instructional hours above state requirements, and afterschool tutoring, Lorain Bilingual Academy is undergoing steady academic recovery since the pandemic. As required by state law, Richland Academy of the Arts (RAA) provides oversight, monitoring and technical assistance to the schools it sponsors including evaluating the academic, fiscal and organizational performance in various ways. In addition to assessing academic performance as measured by state report card metrics, RAA reviews various academic progress and financial reports, attends board meetings, assesses compliance with state and federal rules and laws, and conducts school site visits.
